## What is the Parallel Studies Program?

The Parallel Studies Program at Deree offers students the opportunity to enroll at Deree in parallel to their studies at a Greek public university. 1046 Greek public university students in Deree are currently pursuing parallel studies.

If you are a Greek public university student and want to broaden your horizons, you can pursue a bachelor's degree at Deree (a major) or complement your studies with a minor – a 6-course program in the field of your interest.

Deree offers **35 innovative programs** and **50 minors** spanning business studies, liberal arts, sciences, and fine and performing arts.

By combining two academic fields, you can tailor your dream career based on your interests. For example, if you are a law student wishing to specialize in human rights, you can study Psychology in parallel at Deree; Architecture with Marketing; Computer Engineering with Graphic Design... the possibilities are many! Combined knowledge and exposure to two educational systems will equip you with a unique skillset that will help you stand out in the global job market.
